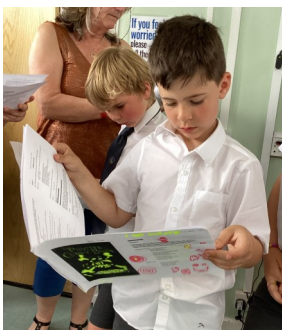

A huge thank you to the FEMS team for organising and running this event and to all of the families who supported it by sending in their children with a donation.

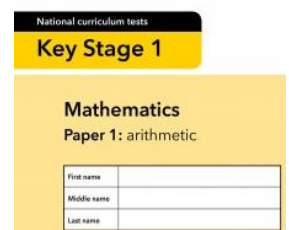


Year 2 SATs

This week Year 2 children have been completing their SATs tests.

As you may be aware, this is the first year that all End of Key Stage 1 assessments have become non-statutory. Schools are no longer required to carry out the tests or report the results from these to parents or the local authority.

As a school, we felt that getting the children to sit the tests in a calm and supportive environment would be beneficial to the children for two reasons: firstly, to provide the children with a positive initial experience around testing and secondly to support teacher assessments. The children have worked through the tests in a really positive and diligent manner and this has been really praised within the class. Well done Year 2!
