ELSA Diabetes Research Study

Our school has been invited to be involved in a research study exploring Type 1 diabetes. All children are able to take part in a screening activity with a simple finger stick blood test to find out their risk of getting Type 1 diabetes. Hopefully you will have received the email with information about this study and how to sign up. If this has not reached you, please let us know and we can provide you with it. The nurses will be coming to school on Tuesday 3rd June to carry out the screening for those children where parental consent has been given.
