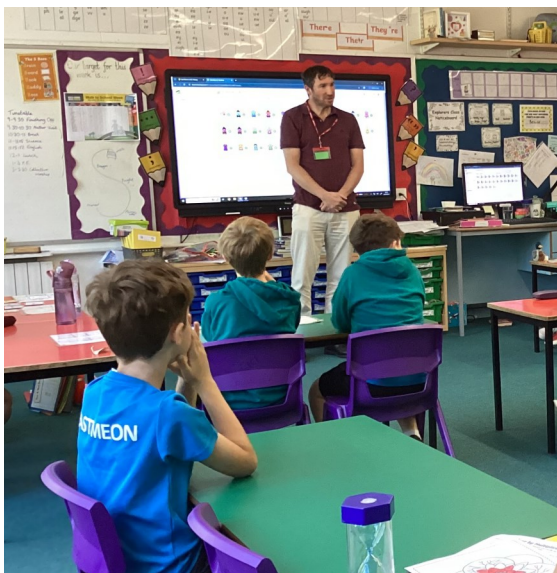


Walk to School Week
