Friday 4th July 9.30-11.30am—Transition Session 3 (Children stay on their own, parents drop off and collect)

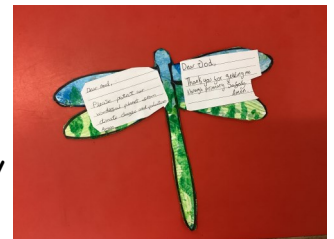
Year 6 Transition Plans
