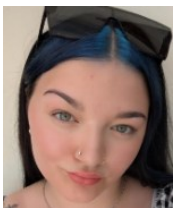

This week we have welcomed four new members of staff to our team:



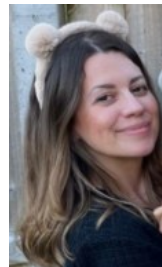
Miss Rose will be working as a learning support assistant in Discoverers.
