- Do our best to ensure our child attends school every day and is on time each morning.
- Make sure our child is dressed appropriately for school, as per the school uniform policy.
- Inform the school of any absence in a timely manner. Whenever possible, informing the school office by 9.30am.
- Use appropriate parental controls and monitor our child's use of ICT at home to ensure they are safe and only accessing appropriate content.

- Listen to my teacher's instructions and use their feedback to help me improve.
- Embrace the opportunities on offer to me at school.
