Key Stage 2 Technology Wellbeing Workshops

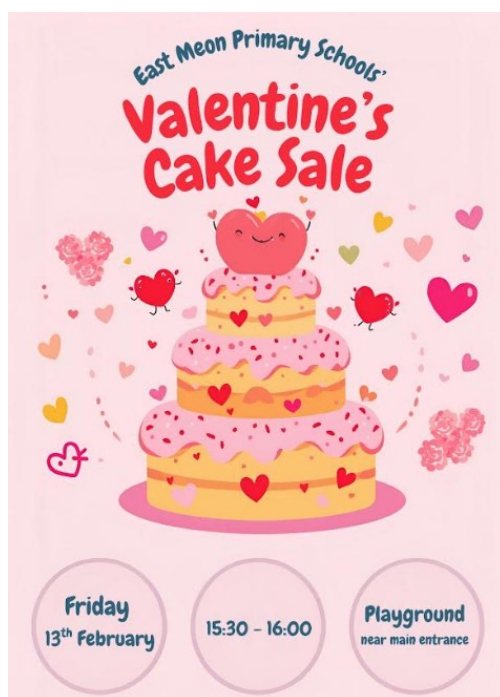
